To encourage women to develop their gifts, passions, and talents to serve Christ.

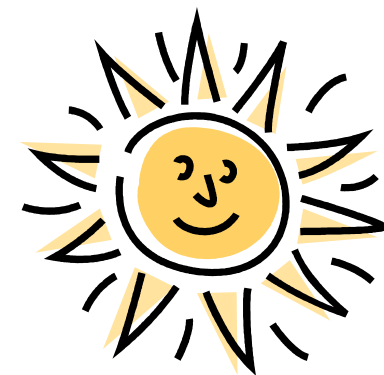
